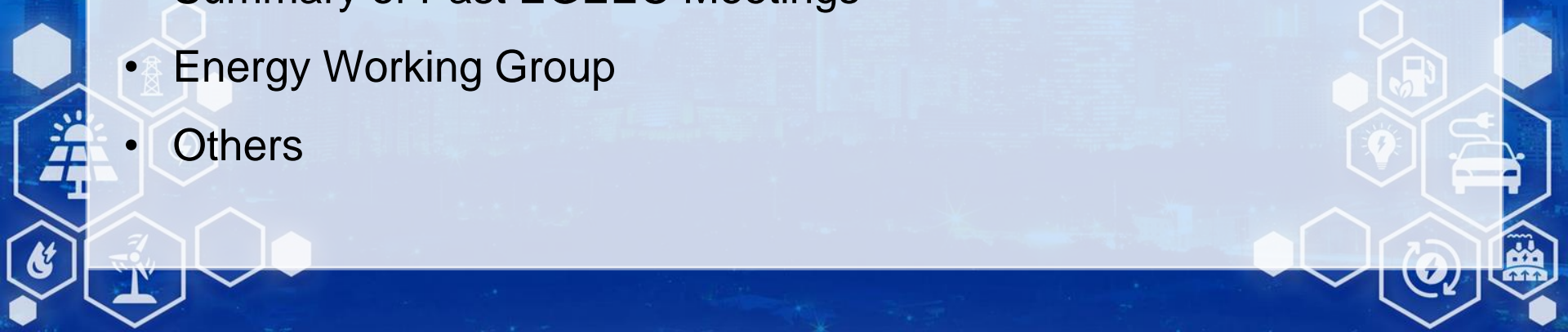



Review of EGEEC Terms of Reference

- The [EGEEC ToR](#) was endorsed by SOM on 26 November 2021.
- The EGEEC ToR has a term of four years starting from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2025.
- Members are encouraged to review the EGEEC ToR and deliberate issues for endorsement by the “consensus” of the member economies.

EGEEC [Terms of Reference \(As of 26 November 2021\)](#)

A. Mission

The APEC Expert Group on Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EGEE&C) was established by APEC Energy Working Group (EWG) in 1993 to assist in achieving energy security, advance economic and social well-being, and to realize environmental benefits in the Asia-Pacific region through energy conservation and the application of energy-efficiency practices and technologies.

B. Objectives

The following objectives have been established to accomplish the mission:
Enhance cooperation to achieve greater energy efficiency towards APEC's aspirational goal of reducing energy intensity by at least 45% by 2035, using 2005 as a base year;

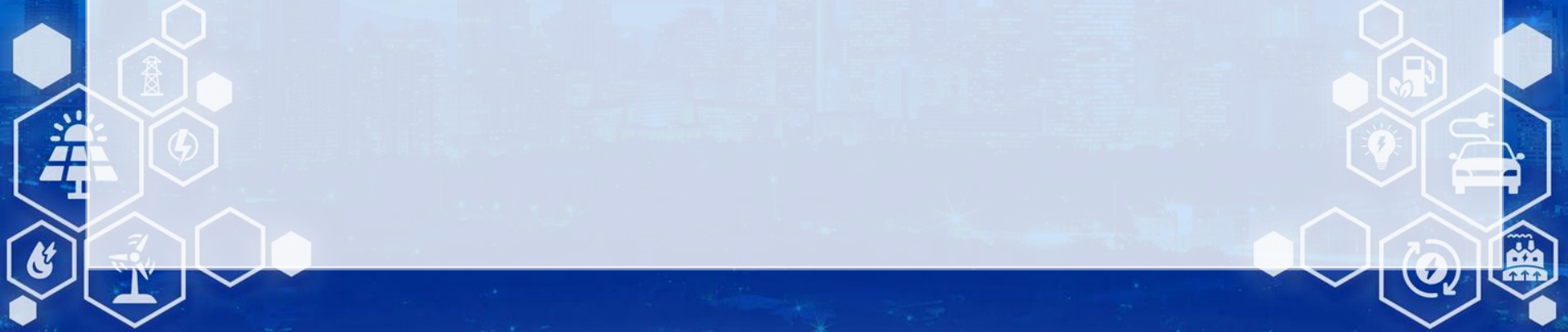
- Advance the application of energy efficiency practices and technologies in opportune end-use sectors (residential, commercial, industrial, agricultural, transportation, etc.);
- Assist in developing and enhancing trade in energy efficient products and services between APEC member economies;
- Contribute to international efforts to reduce the adverse impacts of energy production and consumption upon our global environment; and
- Improve the analytical, technical, operational and policy capacity for energy efficiency and conservation within APEC member economies.

C. Strategies

The strategies consist of the following major elements:

- EGEEEC Members are encourage to express their interest in hosting the EGEEEC meetings in the second half of 2024 and 2025.
