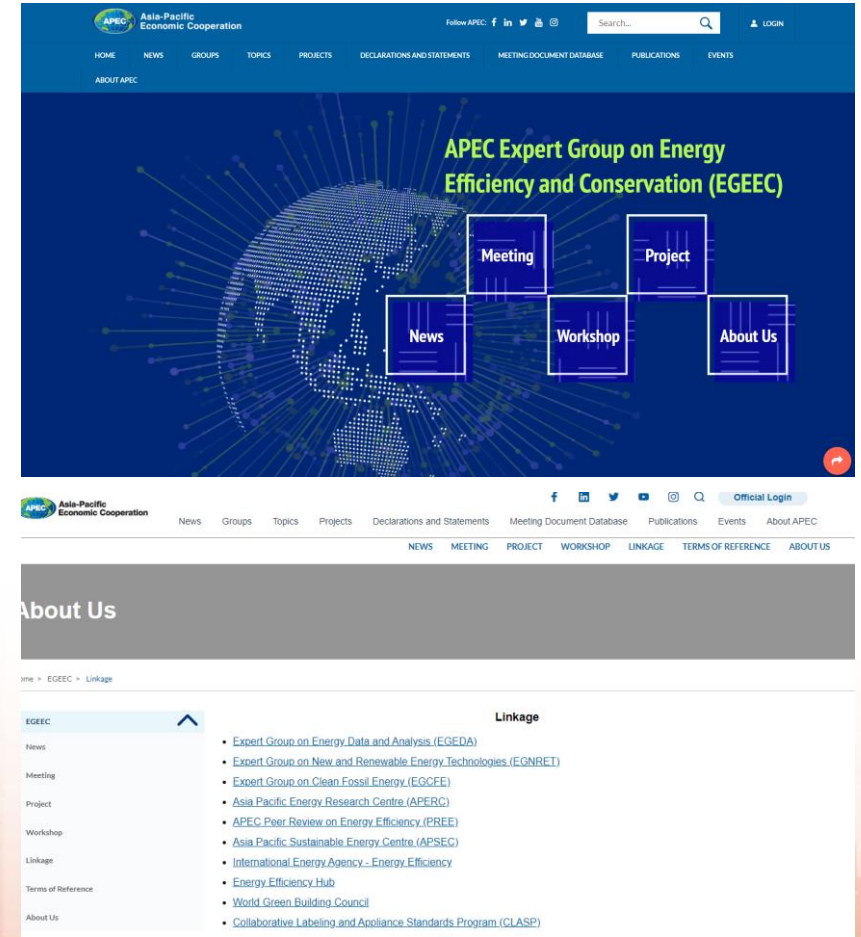

- Members are encouraged to regularly review and update the EGEEC contact list to build capacity and share knowledge in energy efficiency and conservation-related policy.



Terms of Reference

- The [EGEEC ToR](#) was endorsed by SOM on 26 November 2021.
- The EGEEC ToR has a term of four years starting from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2025.
- Members are urged to review the EGEE&C ToR and deliberate issues for endorsement by the “consensus” of the member economies.

The 'C. Strategies' section begins with the text 'The strategies consist of the following major elements:'.

EGEEC Logo Selection

- The EGEEC (since 1993) has been established for 30 years.
- In the last meeting (EGEEC61), members proposed and agreed to create a logo to improve visibility and communication.
- Members were invited to submit their design from 31 Jan 2024 to 30 April 2024.
- By the submission deadline, one (1) submission was received. The logo and its description was circulated to members via email, and is also shown on the following slide.
- A logo is preferably neutral, timeless, and aesthetically pleasing, creating a strong first impression while effectively representing our identity.
- Given that there is only one submission, there will be no selection. The submission would be circulated with all members for endorsement. Members may express their views on the submission now or by email.

EGEEC Logo Selection – Submission #1

This design features a series of overlapping circular letters "EGEEC" in shades of blue and green, symbolising the collaborative, continuous, and interconnected nature of the EGEEC's work in addressing global environmental challenges while promoting sustainable development simultaneously.

The logo includes an "infinity" symbol, signifying the perpetual advancement of energy-efficient practices and technologies.

The design also pays tribute to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) by sharing the similar letter "C" to reaffirm our commitment to addressing climate change.



Upcoming EGEEC Meetings

- China will host the EGEEC63 meeting in the second half of 2024, in conjunction with the APSEC 10th Anniversary Forum.
- Hong Kong, China will host the Joint meeting for 4 expert groups in Spring 2025.
- Member economies who are interested in hosting the EGEEC meeting in the second half of 2025 are encouraged to contact the EGEEC Secretariat.
- The secretariat will follow up with Host Economy on the arrangement of the meeting and circulate the detail to all EGEEC members soon.
